Synod of the Northeast Emerging Gospel Communities Grant Criteria Checklist

Grant Maximum = \$20,000 per year for 2 years (\$40,000 total). Applicants must reapply for 2nd year funding.

The Emerging Gospel Community described by the applicant:

- □ Represents a new or developing (in its first several years of existence) gathering of people.
- □ Builds ongoing relationships between participants.
- □ Centers on a shared interest in and commitment to the teaching of Jesus.

Criteria related to Innovation

This Emerging Gospel Community application describes a project that:

- □ Is truly creative, innovative, and entrepreneurial.
- Mobilizes the Presbyterian community to engage with its neighbors and the needs of the world in a way that will bring a fresh experience of Christ's love to both the local and Presbyterian communities.
- Exhibits an experimental edge that will provide a source of learning both for those living it out and the larger Synod community.

Criteria related to Leadership and Partnerships

This Emerging Gospel Community application describes a project that:

- □ Is led by a team or teams of people responsible for the flourishing of the project.
- □ Focuses on developing strong partnerships in support of the project.
- □ Fosters connections within the broader community.
- □ Maintains a solid connection to the Presbytery in which it is present.

Criteria related to Synod Values

This Emerging Gospel Community application describes a project that:

Community

□ Draws people into meaningful relationships with one another.

Diversity & Inclusion

□ Helps bridge difference and promotes greater understanding between people.

Missional Identity

□ Addresses real needs in the community and world with the hope, care, and love of Jesus Christ.

Partnership

□ Shares commitments with the Synod's work to promote justice and vitality within our region and world.

Criteria related to the Budget/Financials

This Emerging Gospel Community Grant application's financials provide:

□ A clear explanation of the financial components of the project.

□ A snapshot of the funding sources for the project that demonstrates a diversity of funding sources (not reliant on Synod funds alone).

□ A description of how Synod funds will be used to support the project.

□ (For Year 2 applications) A plan for financial sustainability after Emerging Gospel Community grant funds are exhausted.

Red Flags - Checks in the boxes below will require conversation between the applicant and the Synod's Mission Working Group for additional discernment/clarity.

This application:

□ Centers on the work of one inspiring individual rather than a strong core team of participants.

□ Seeks funding for ongoing staff salaries.

Seeks funding for building projects intended to attract/begin a ministry ("if we build it, they will come") as opposed to a building project that enhances or clears impediments to an already flourishing ministry?
